DIRECTIONS TO THE TECH MUSEUM

201 S. Market St., San Jose, CA 95113

Please enter through the main entrance on 201 S. Market Street directly across from the park. This will be the only available entrance; all other entrances will be closed because the workshop is during the museum's off-hours.

- *From San Francisco:* Take 101 south toward downtown San Jose. Exit Guadalupe Parkway (Highway 87). Continue 2-1/2 miles through city streets, then onto the parkway. Exit Park Avenue/San Carlos Street. Turn left on Park. The Tech Museum is on the corner of Park Avenue and Market Street.
- *From downtown Oakland, Hayward, Castro Valley and points East:* Take 880 south toward San Jose. Take the Coleman Avenue exit and turn left. Drive 3 miles, where it will turn into Market Street. Once you cross Santa Clara Street, The Tech Museum will be two blocks down on the right, at the corner of Park Avenue and Market Street.
- *From eastern Berkeley, Orinda etc.:* Take CA-24 toward Oakland. Take CA-13 south exit toward Hayward. Take I-580 east via the exit on the left toward HAYWARD/STOCKTON. Take the #34 exit toward I-880 onto I-238 N. Take I-880 South toward SAN JOSE. Take the Coleman Avenue exit and turn left. Drive 3 miles, where it will turn into Market Street. Once you cross Santa Clara Street, The Tech Museum will be two blocks down on the right, at the corner of Park Avenue and Market Street.
