

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING YOUR COMPUTER ON CAMPUS

In order to use the campus network, **your computer must have the latest security patches installed**. The campus network will not allow you to connect without these updates.

Wired Connection (Ethernet)

All of the dorms have high speed internet access. You will need to have an Ethernet card and your own Ethernet patch cable to connect the computer to the network (a phone/modem cable will not work). The first time you connect the computer, you should open your web browser to go through an automated registration process.

Wireless Connection

Before you can connect to the wireless network, you must first register your wireless card. Just go to <http://wirelessreg.pomona.edu> and enter the name and enter the:

The following User Name and Password are for both wired and wireless connections:

User: guest25
Password: Violin!925

Otherwise, drop by the Help Desk at the IT Building located at 156 W. 7th Street, Claremont. They will take down the necessary information and wireless access will be granted. It takes a minimum of 24 hours and up to two business days for the registration process. (Note: summer hours for the Help desk are 8:00 am to 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday.)

DID YOU BRING A TELEPHONE??

TO CALL 911 FOR EMERGENCIES, DIAL EXTENSION 72000 (CAMPUS SAFETY) THEY WILL DISPATCH EMERGENCY SERVICES

- ∞ **Identify the extension of your dorm room by finding the telephone jack and locating the white label. This label has your dorm room extension written on it.**
- ∞ **If it is not identified with an extension number, dial “O” and the operator will share it with you.**
- ∞ **All numbers have direct dial access. To convert your extension to a direct dial number, add 909/607-XXXX.**

To dial extensions within the campus:

- ∞ **Simply dial the 5-digit extension.**

To make local calls:

- ∞ **Dial “9” then the telephone number. Remember to dial “1” if the number is out of the 909 area code.**

To make long distance calls:

- ∞ **AT&T: Dial #7000 + (do not depress the number “1” that usually precedes the area code) + area code + telephone number + credit card number.**
- ∞ **MCI: Dial 10102220 + area code + telephone number + MCI calling card number.**
- ∞ **Sprint: Dial 103330 + area code + telephone number + Sprint calling card number.**
- ∞ **800 calls: Dial “9” then the 800 number.**
